Community Image Awards

The Winners

(Introduced by Marie Dodd)

Coastal Medical Access Project

In 2001, leaders from Camden, Glynn and McIntosh counties - concerned about the growing problem of healthcare access for area residents - formed the Coastal Medical Access Project (CMAP).

CMAP provides three services: primary care, free pharmaceuticals, and the management of care for people living with a chronic illness.

CMAP's mission is to help build a healthier community through increased access to healthcare, accomplished through collaboration among the medical community, faith-based organizations, local businesses and volunteers. This Club's own Eric Andreae is CMAP's Director of Volunteer Medicine.

Approximately 24,000 people in Camden, Glynn and McIntosh counties who are uninsured or under-insured may be helped by CMAP programs. They are not on Medicaid or Medicare. They are working, but their employers do not offer health insurance. CMAP also serves people who are retired, have worked all their lives but are not quite old enough for Medicare.

Accepting for CMAP was Pat Koda, Chief Executive Officer.

Laura Cross McKinley

Laura Cross McKinley was honored for the volume and quality of her engagement in our community.

She leads a busy professional life as President and CEO of Oglethorpe Bank, but also finds time to serve her community.

She serves on the boards of Communities in Schools, Foundation of the College of Coastal Georgia, and was on the Steering Committee of the Charter Technical School. She is on the Glynn-Brunswick Memorial Hospital Authority, the Cooperative Health Care Services, Inc. board of Southeast Georgia Health System, and she formerly served on the board of CMAP.

She is the Past-President of the Coastal Symphony of Georgia, Chair of its Cabaret 2009, and remains active in the Symphony, Youth Symphony, and Symphony Society. She also serves (with our own Marie Dodd) on the Glynn County Airport Commission.
