June 24, 2008 Outgoing President's Report

President **Jim Bruce** reported on the following goals that were set when he took office in July 2007:

- 1. Get back to 130 members (from 123). This goal was met and the net gain of 7 members far exceeded the district goal of a 1% increase.
- 2. Meet the obligation of \$100 per member contribution to the Rotary Foundation. The club achieved \$117 per member.
- 3. Work on club recognition and image. Twenty-four articles were printed about our activities, plus several district newsletter articles.
- 4. Add to our charity activities, participate in METS and apply for a district grant. Our first major contribution ever was made to METS – with acknowledgement to Myra Hocutt for the gift of 20 hospital beds from Magnolia Manor. We expanded our relationship with the St. Simons Elementary School to support its special needs in addition to our ongoing tutoring activity. We applied for a district grant but were not successful.
- 5. Accomplish some new membership initiatives. We added the Hall of Fame recognition, initiated the buying of SSI Rotary shirts to let others know who we are, and we revised our directory with new color photos.

Pat Donahoo, past club president and past district governor, installed the new officers and directors, using the keyword of "commitment" for the coming year.
