Charles Stewart County Administrator

The county administrator gave club members a general overview of trends in county government as well as some specific information on current projects.

As in other parts of the country, growth in property values has slowed which – in addition to the general slowing of the economy – will affect government revenues at all levels, he said. He added that the trend is expected to continue next year.

He also reported on these projects:

New Casino Building – It has been well used this year and is expected to continue to attract public events of all kinds.

Neptune Park Development – Bids on the renovation will be opened in September and the project is expected to be completed by next summer.

Gateway Project – The contract for this project, which will alter traffic patterns for entering and leaving the island, will be awarded in October, with completion expected 13 months later.

Stewart is a native of Washington, DC. A 1964 graduate of St. Thomas University in St. Paul, Minnesota, he came to the Brunswick area in 1975 as finance director for the Coastal Area Planning and Development Commission (now the Regional Development Center).

He joined Glynn County in 1979 as finance director and became county administrator in 1983, a role he served in for 10 years. He then spent time as a health care administrator with First American Home Health or, as it was better known, ABC Home Health, for six years.

His career path then took him to a local nonprofit organization as finance director. In 2003, he rejoined Glynn County government as county administrator.

Stewart has lived on St. Simons for more than 32 years. He and his wife of 41 years have three children and seven grandchildren.
