Live Oak Transplanting William E. deVos Registered Consulting Arborist

As a consultant to the Sea Island Company for tree preservation and care, deVos oversaw the transplanting of hundreds of live oaks at the company's new development called Frederica.

Smaller trees were moved using large machines, often called tree spades, while the larger trees were excavated in a wide circle (to protect as much of the root system as possible) and then dragged to its new site using a "slider."

The largest tree moved had a trunk 70 inches in diameter and was 80 feet tall, with a 90-foot branch spread.

He said the transplanted trees needed to be carefully watered and nourished, using custom-blended fertilizer. "They did live in a communal situation," he said. "Now they're isolated."

Some trees were lost, he said, but a large majority survived.

The tree consultant is a fan of the sturdy live oak: "Live oaks have a constitution like no other I've ever seen."

Based in Vermont, deVos is former chairman of the Vermont Urban and Community Forestry Council, and past president of the New England International Society of Arboriculture.

An 11-time recipient of the National Award for Excellence in Arboriculture, deVos has been a consultant to the Sea Island Company for five years.

Al Brown

Senior Vice President, Sea Island Company

Prior to the arborist's presentation, Brown talked about Sea Island Company's Frederica development, which comprises 3000 acres in the northern portion of St. Simons Island.

In addition to the boathouse, a large clubhouse has been built on the grounds of the Tom Fazio-designed golf course, and there is a large lake that will be 400 acres when completed.

The company is selling large lots – two to six acres each – ranging in price from \$1 million to \$3.5 million.
