Vernon Humbert

Musical Director

Coastal Symphony of Georgia

Vernon Humbert serves as Musical Director of the Coastal Symphony of Georgia and as First Cello for the Jacksonville Symphony.

He gave a preview of the upcoming Coastal Symphony season and demonstrated his musical ability on the cello.

He said a musical director must respect the orchestra's musicians and they will return that respect.

Humbert earned his bachelor's degree in music education from Eastern Illinois University and a master's degree in cello performance from the University of Illinois.

He began his symphonic career performing with the Nashville Symphony Orchestra and has been a section cellist in Jacksonville, Florida, since 1981.

Humbert enjoys performing chamber music, playing in summer chamber workshops, and has studied with musicians such as Manachem Pressler of the Beaux Artes Trio and Susan Salm of the Raphael Trio.

In 2000, Humbert and two colleagues from the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra founded Prelude Chamber Music, Inc., an organization that provides a two-week summer camp to teach musicianship and teamwork through chamber music for middle and high school string students.

The Coastal Symphony of Georgia began in 1982, with the purpose of providing concert programs and related educational opportunities for the general public, including young people.

Full orchestra concerts are performed each season under the direction of Humbert, with approximately 55 performing artists. The orchestra is made up of the best musicians in the area and invited guest artists.

Humbert and his wife Elaine have three daughters, and all family members play a musical instrument.

Humbert said his favorite composer is Aaron Copeland "because his style makes the listener forget the worries of life and enjoy the moment."
