Kenan Karter, past Dist. Gov. thanked our club for the brick we purchased in his honor for Veteran's Walk. He recognized <u>Chuck Cansler</u> for his outstanding leadership last year. He presented <u>Jim Bruce</u> with a plaque and a gift for being District Webmaster and for handling registration for the District Conference. He also presented our club, as home of the Dist. Gov. Clyde Taylor, the <u>District Banner</u> to keep this year.

Speaker Lisa Liguori, heads up the UGA Fisheries Dept. of the Marine Extension Service. She conducts outreach projects in Coastal GA. She deals with environmental issues through <u>Wisdom</u>, <u>Justice</u> and <u>Moderation</u>.

<u>Wisdom</u> is the research done to find practical solutions to specific questions, problems and controversies and listening to local people. An example of this is how a local resident, Sinkey Boone, helped develop an effective turtle excluder device for shrimpers.

<u>Justice</u> is getting scientific information out to the public who might not have access to it. An example of this is the Glynn Co. Seafood Advisory stating that children under 7 and women of childbearing age should eat only 1 serving of local fish or crab per month. This is a result of contaminants infiltrating the water from the former LCP plant, which was closed in 1976.

<u>Moderation is taking a small step at a time to</u> address environmental issues. Examples of this are talking to grocery shoppers about using reusable grocery bags, and a recycling program with the local Boys and Girls Clubs collecting bottles, cans and other trash from around their clubs, neighborhoods and parks.

Lisa cautions us that all crabs should be cleaned before cooking to remove contaminants stored in their fat and liver. Local shrimp, on the other hand, are safe to eat because they do not live long enough to absorb the contaminants, and this also supports our local shrimpers! Whenever possible, we were encouraged to eat wild seafood as opposed to farm raised seafood.
