President Brooke Pridmore presented visiting Rotarian **Nancy Harris** with a banner from our club to take back to her Gwinnett Mosaic Rotary Club.

Speaker, <u>Father Thomas Healy</u> was born in Cork, Ireland. In addition to being an ordained Catholic priest, he's also a lawyer and has a master's degree in education. He spent 8 months at the monastery of Great St.-Bernard in Switzerland. Ironically, today, the riders in the Tour de France will be scaling the snowcapped Grand Saint-Bernard pass. In 2006 he was appointed pastor of St. Joseph's Parish in Waycross, GA.

Father Thomas Healy spoke about what is happening in Europe.....the spirituality of Europe. He included his personal impressions with those of authors and journalists in the following statements.

Europe is very different now because of the two World Wars. The Holocaust and acts of wars have left deep scars in Europe. At least 50 million people died during those wars. In order to survive, Europe must retain what's best in its heritage.

Europe has gone down the path which could lead to its own demise. If Europe abandons her religious heritage the idea of Europe will die. It is now post-Christian. There are "believers" in Europe, but they do not belong to or attend a church. Many churches are being destroyed. There are 300 deserted churches in Scotland. Many people are leaving Holland because they have no confidence in the future stability of the nation. Some experts predict that Germany will be Islamic in 100 years.

Arabs and Muslims have brought anti-Semitism to Europe. There are 15 million Muslims in Europe. Europe is in danger of becoming an Islamic state due to its refusal to go back to its Christian heritage. If it does not restore its Christian values it will die

The following books are recommended:

- While Europe Slept by Bruce Bawer. It makes a strong statement about Europe's politically correct culture that's allowing and protecting a Muslim fundamentalist movement that takes advantage of their social systems.
- Londonistan by Malanie Phillips. It is about radical Islamic fundamentalism, which is growing in Britain.
