Speaker **John Oxendine** has served as Georgia Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner for 15 years. He regulates more than 1,600 insurance companies, licensing 137,000 insurance agents and regulating over 1,000 industrial loan offices, which make loans of \$3,000 or less.

Commissioner Oxendine announced that he is running for Governor. He stated that the main governmental concerns have been transportation, education and water. He stressed that these are state concerns and not just Atlanta concerns

Now, the main concern is health care. He stated that the main fear is that the patient – doctor relationship on personal healthcare decisions is going to be put into the hands of the government. This he feels would be a conflict of interest. The government could be making decisions on personal healthcare choices, not you and your doctor, and the government would also be paying for the care. This would not just concern senior citizens, but young people, who do not have a good prognosis for recovery. This is when it would start to become a business decision.....a cost benefit analysis. He sees having a "waiting" period for health care procedures and high taxes to pay for the health care as other main concerns with the current proposal.

Even though Commissioner Oxendine is not a Rotarian, he is a Paul Harris Fellow!
