Phillip E. Carlyle

New to club membership in 2009, Phil Carlyle was introduced by Jerry Schueneman, organizer of Classification Talks.

Phil counts himself one of three active club members raised in Griffin, GA. Following high school in Griffin, he served in the Marine Corps and then attended Clayton State University.

While at Clayton State, he took physics as a summer course from current Club President, Brooke Pridmore. The course was required for his admission to Palmer College of Chiropractic. Phil credits President Brooke with imparting a life lesson: Each of us has the ability to do a great deal. The challenge is to make the correct choices.

Phil graduated from Palmer in 1999 and established Carlyle Chiropractic Clinic in June 1999 to diagnose and treat common spinal misalignments. The clinic also treats back pain, sciatica, neck pain, shoulder pain, headaches, sports and work-related injuries.

He also referenced a Paris Rotary Club meeting with over 500 attending in a beautiful banquet hall. There was also the Upstate New York Club meeting where Canadian members sat on one side of the table and US members sat on the opposite side.

Pat encouraged new club members to take part in club activities and to attend the District Conference. He promised that the more each club member engaged with Rotary, the more they would benefit from their membership.
