February 9 Program

Hank Coxe Nationally Known Trial Lawyer and Past President of the Florida Bar Association

Hank was born in Pennsylvania but decided early on that he did not want to live in the North with the snow.

He proceeded to attend college at The University of the South in Sewanee, TN (still snow), then moved on to Virginia (still snow), where he attended law school at Washington and Lee University in Lexington.

He eventually wised up and moved to Jacksonville FL where there is no snow!

He was president of the Jacksonville Bar Association, as well as the Florida Bar Association, and was voted one of the Top 10 lawyers by his peers in the State of Florida.

Hank received the Florida Bar Association pro bono award and prosecuted the first televised case in Florida. From this he was offered a spot in an orange juice commercial for Winn Dixie. His line was very simple. However, after 21 takes, he was encouraged to go back to prosecuting cases.

Hank was very entertaining and shared several tidbits of information and interesting stories, such as;

--There are 88,000 lawyers in the State of Florida with 11 law schools. Law schools are the most profitable to operate and requires the least amount of capital investment.

-- Some people say there are too many lawyers; others say it is a free country.

-- 10.8 million dollars per year are dedicated to the oversight of lawyers. New Jersey is the toughest state with Florida being second. In New Jersey, if an attorney is disbarred, he/she can never get back in. Florida allows lawyers who have been disbarred to reapply after 10 years.

--While standing in the security line in an airport a fellow in front of him commented, "I bet you are an attorney". He answered back very proudly, "Yes I am, how can you tell?" The man replied, "You are wearing a tie, carrying a briefcase and have lousy hair."
