## Classification Talk By Myra Albert

Speaker Myra Albert is from Englewood, New Jersey. After high school she attended Parsons School of Design and worked for a while as an interior decorator. She, however, never felt that this was a good fit for her.

After marrying and having two children, she began working on her BA degree and she eventually received a Master's Degree in Library Science, and later received a Master's degree in criminal justice.

During this time, prison reforms were taking place which included hiring prison librarians to build libraries, including law libraries. Myra eventually became the first woman librarian in a male prison in N.Y. State. She was elected by the prison guards to be on the inmate grievance committee. Later, she was elected by the inmates to represent them.

During the 80's and 90's Myra applied for and received grants to fund programs for library service from private foundations. One such program provided college professors to go to five different maximum-security prisons for four sessions each to present lectures based on some aspect of black studies. These programs were well received by the inmates.

Myra became an adjunct professor for Marist College as a second job in the prisons. She also produced a video to explain what a library can do for inmates.

Myra will be taking a Leave of Absence for a few months, but when she returns, she will be more than happy to share with us what life was like *"behind bars for fifteen years"*!
