Speaker, **Gary Colberg**, President of the Southeast Georgia Health System, covered a number of projects in which the hospital is involved. There is a clinic at the **International Seafarer's Center** for people coming into the port of Brunswick who are sick or need medicine. Those having the correct visas or passports are treated at the hospital.

The Cancer Care Center is one of only 9 affiliated programs with M. C. Anderson in Houston, TX. The doctors there participate in discussions with doctors here concerning treatment. The hospital has applied to be the second Cyber Knife Site in Georgia for cancer treatment. The Breast Care Center, which will open Oct. 5th, is part of this center.

The **Senior Care Center** was updated with \$100,000 from the Eastern Health System Foundation. They will soon open a 30 bed **Memory Care Unit**.

The \$30,000,000 **Camden County Expansion** added 90,000 square feet to the facility there. With orthopedic doctors and neurosurgeons on site and chemo, CT and MRI available, it is a turnkey facility ready to start. Hopefully, it will be the VA site for the Brunswick area.

The Merriam – Hugh Nunnally Maternity Care Center was funded by a \$1,000,000 donation by the Nunnallys. In Glynn Co., 64% of births are through Medicaid!

The 20,000 square foot office building on **Wellness Way** is attached to the St. Simons Immediate Care Center.

The Joint Replacement Center will open Oct. 12th.

A **Community Care Center** has been set up to provide for medical services to Medicaid patients.

The concern about healthcare, with all the new people coming into healthcare, is "Where are the providers going to come from to see them?". We will see a need for physician assistants and nurse practitioners with the authority to prescribe. As it is now, physicians and "for profit" hospitals are not mandated to accept Medicaid or Medicare. There are rumors that providers will have to agree to take Universal Insurance, and that Medicare providers are going to get cut about 21%.

Only 31% of Medicare money goes to doctors and hospitals. The rest goes to pharmaceutical companies and other healthcare providers. SEHS charges 15% less than any GA hospital and is seeing a decrease in collection. Around 65–70% of Emergency Room patients, out of 100,000 a year, are inappropriate. All ER patients are billed, but not up front.
