President Brooke presented **Steven Spandle** with his Blue Badge.

Speaker **Sophia Porson**, has been a translator and interpreter for eight presidents. She speaks 5 languages: English, French, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese. She has worked with organizations such as the World Bank, International Trade Union, and various scientific groups. Her career with the Department of State in Washington, D. C. began with the Eisenhower administration and ended with the early Clinton years. Her travels have taken her all over the United States and 90 foreign countries

She connected Georgia to the remodeling of the Diplomatic Reception Rooms for the State Department during the Kennedy administration. Dean Rusk of Georgia was Secretary of State then, and brought in a famous architect from Albany, GA, Edward Mason Jones, and craftsmen of Georgia to turn the facility into elegant 18th century drawing rooms.

She found President Reagan a wonderful person with whom to work and credits him, out of the 8 with whom she worked, as having had the most impact on our lives.

Mrs. Porson became interested in learning various languages as the daughter of a U. S. Diplomat.
