#### **Mayor Bryan Thompson**

Bryan Thompson was elected Mayor of the City of Brunswick in November 2005, and re-elected with no opposition in November 2009. His work has centered on issues of housing, public safety, and focused, directed growth that will increase benefits and opportunities equitably for everyone in the community.

He is on several local and regional boards and committees including the TSPLOST Roundtable; Jekyll Island Advisory Committee; Glynn County Health Department: Mavor's Committee on Services for the Disabled: Policy Committee for the Brunswick Area Transportation Study (BATS), and the Archway Executive Committee. He is married to Heather Heath, Executive Director of Golden Isles Arts and Humanities Association, the coordinating arts council for Glynn County and the City of Brunswick.

## Program - January 25, 2011

### **Lorette Hoover, President, Altamaha Technical College**

"Our employers are our #1 customer." according to Lorette Hoover, president of the Altamaha Technical College, who said that ATC graduates are usually snapped up by local businesses. In 2009, almost 98 percent of its graduates found jobs – in the health care field, 100 percent found jobs.

With the expansion of the college into Glynn and Camden counties in 2009, ATC became the fastest-growing two-year college in the nation. It has racked up some other impressive statistics, as well. The graduation rate is 77 percent – the highest in Georgia. For four of the past 20 years, it has had one of the highest graduation rates in the nation. Enrollment this year is 2,887; in Glynn County, 729.

Hoover noted that district Rotary Clubs have donated scholarship funds over the years. The St. Simons Rotary Club has donated five GED scholarships.
