# Tom Sublett—Chairman, Glynn County Commission

Tom Sublett shared with us his "state of the county" presentation. He described the new commission as a group who debates intelligently and disagrees respectfully. Following his presentation, Tom accepted questions and discussed the following topics. **Causeway Barrier**: Ahead of schedule and should be completed in about six weeks.

Postell Park: The last major project for the Village.

**Recycling**: Playing "catch-up" but progress has been made. **Left Turn out of Marina**: Intersection will be reworked to provide a full-service intersection with left and right turn access.

**Merging Services between the County and City**: Being considered with the intention of the city maintaining its identity.

**Commercial Real Estate**: In order for the Golden Isles to be considered a top tier community, we have to continue improving safety and security, providing venues such as biking and walking trails and maintaining existing facilities.

**Jail Location**: The location of the jail has been narrowed to two sites outside of downtown Brunswick.
