Tim Deegan

First Coast News Meteorologist and Weather Forecaster

Tim Deegan, *First Coast News* Meteorologist in Jacksonville, shared some personal history and experiences during an informative talk centered on his 30-year career in weather forecasting. A native of Corpus Christi, Texas and a graduate of Texas A&M, Tim has held his position at *First Coast News* since 1982. Tim described his “passion” for the weather as a result of his childhood affliction with asthma which kept him housebound and looking out the window at the clouds. This limitation blossomed into an interest in weather in general evolving into advanced climate study which has continued throughout his entire life.

Tim discussed several career experiences including his encounter with Hurricane Gilbert in South Florida in 1988. He and his crew flew into the eye of the hurricane six times to measure Gilbert as the strongest hurricane to have hit the Atlantic basin up to that time. Tim also discussed the causes of tornadoes and hurricanes and added some insight into what we might expect in 2011 in another La Nina year. A round of questions followed his talk including his answer that global warming is probably effected by increased energy in the atmosphere which is in fact, produced my mankind.
