Chuck Cansler accepted the award on the Land Trust's behalf. He shared that the Land Trust, among other ventures, secured conservation easements on 26 properties, is in the process of acquiring the Cannon Point property which consists of 600 acres, and has plans to complete the trail system from Harris Teeter to the bridge.
