Centerville Rotary Club Receives X-Ray Equipment for Transport to a Developing Nation

The Rehoboth Life Care Ministries, Inc. (RLCM) has donated a previously unneeded Panorex X-Ray machine and two film development units to the Rotary Club of Centerville. This equipment will be shipped to the Rotary District 6920 Medical Equipment Transport Service warehouse in Savannah, where all collected donated equipment and supplies are received, sorted, and packed for further shipment to developing countries. Yesmin Wilson, Director of Rehoboth Life Care Ministries, said she is grateful that Rotary can make equipment such as the Panorex X-Ray machine available to developing countries. She went on to say that when participating in a mission to a developing country that the volunteers are overwhelmed with joy when they find equipment with which they are familiar that can be used in their mission work.
