Two national champions, a Preakness winner, several second- and third-place Kentucky Derby winners, and 74 stake winners in all mark the immediate highlights of Dogwood Stable- the original racing partnership. Dogwood Stable President W. Cothran "Cot" Campbell formulated the idea of partnerships in 1969 and has

never looked back. The concept of group ownership of Thoroughbreds appealed to Cot Campbell because it allowed people the opportunity to participate in the racing world at a reasonable cost. This simple idea became a success beyond his wildest dreams. Cot opened the presentation with, "My life depends on four-legged animals to

get from Point A to Point B before other four-legged animals." And then he proceeded to charm the audience with a string of stories that showed his life as an owner of thoroughbreds was a lot more exciting than that. Campbell sold his Atlanta ad agency in the early '70s to open Dogwood Stable in Greenville, Ga., moving it to Aiken, S.C., in 1986. Pictured above is the Dogwood Stable Office in Aiken.
