In 2004, Judge Wood was sworn in as the United States Attorney for the Southern District of Georgia. As United States Attorney, she was the chief federal law enforcement officer for the forty-three counties included in the Southern District of Georgia. In 2007, The United States Senate unanimously confirmed Judge Wood to become the first female federal District Court judge for the Southern District of Georgia. On May 5, 2010, Judge Wood was sworn in as the District's new chief Judge. She currently serves on the Executive Committee of the United States Council for the Fleventh Circuit.

# Program: January 3, 2012 Lawrence Green, FBI SSRA Avoiding Identity Theft

Our speaker for the first meeting of the new year was Lawrence Green, seasoned FBI agent with the Fraud and Identity Prevention Dept. Agent Green started his informative, eye-opening lecture by encouraging all of us to use a paper shredder as a part of our daily routine at home and office in disposing of correspondence and bills. Shred it, +he said. Seven a document with just your name and address on it, not to mention a credit card number, can be really dangerous to the integrity of your identity.+ He stated that 14% of all fraud in America is identity theft. He examined other types of fraud that we all might encounter, largely through our activity on the Internet, including auction fraud involving websites like eBay, PayPal and others. Green talked about Medicare and prescription fraud, as well as other forms of internet and electronic fraud which includes phishingg(bogus sites and email that appear to legitimate, but are not). He encouraged use of an official website that is helpful in reporting complaints of fraud to the FBI . www.iC3.gov. He ended his compelling lecture by reminding us to, % pet a shredder.+We all use one, right?
