As evidenced by recent news articles, lots has been taking place on our neighboring island, and who better to update us than the Executive Director of the Jekyll Island Authority. The JIA is responsible for the natural and cultural stewardship of Jekyll Island and for providing services, programs, and amenities that maximize benefits to Island visitors and residents. The Authority has 162 full-time personnel and 160 part-time employees. It is financially self-sustaining with an annual budget of approximately \$17 million.



Program: January 17, 2012 Loran Smith Sports Editor – UGA News Sports Reporter Sports and Humor

Lucky for us, Loran Smith was in Southeast Georgia for his annual quail hunting expedition and was able to stop by to entertain us during our weekly luncheon program on January 17th, with encouragement from Martin Turbidy. Loran, who is famous statewide as the ultimate 'bulldog fan,' is a graduate of UGA and you might say "he never left the place," states friend and fellow Rotarian, Marie Dodd. Loran has enjoyed a brilliant career as sports writer, sports broadcaster and sports historian. Elected to the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame in 1997, Loran is also past Chairman of that organization. Sports, particularly UGA football, has been his life. Who can forget his sharing the play-by-play and the microphone with Larry Munson during countless UGA football broadcasts? "Watcha got Loran?" Munson would ask.

Loran's presentation was more of a series of jokes than a speech. Yet, offering one funny story after another, he entertained us with his wit, charm and experiences. "I've always loved a good story," he said. "No one is allowed in the park with a bear behind," he offered, referring to a joke about being followed by a real live bear. He told jokes about moon shining, and one about 'The Chicken Schick Show.' (You had to be there to understand that one.) He talked about his simple early beginnings in Wrightsville, GA (also home to another UGA great, Herschel Walker.) "I've always had a curiosity to explore life," he said.
