If you felt something fall on your head during Victoria Baer's riveting presentation, maybe it was a piece of the sky? Founder and Principal of The New Edge, Inc., a successful ad agency, Ms. Baer addressed pressing issues sensitive to us all – the protection of our personal liberty, private property, and individual rights. "UN Agenda 21 is the dragon we need to watch," she warned. She traces initial covert steps back to 1992 when George H.W. Bush signed the Agenda 21 plan for sustainable development in the 21st century— a "soft" commitment to be monitored by a Commission on Sustainable Development. According to Baer, Clinton strengthened this concept in 1993 by signing an executive order establishing the "President's Council on Sustainable Development." Sound familiar? It should. Both steps lead to major controls of our natural resources and environment.

How do you take a country from Capitalism to Socialism without the masses knowing it? By implementing incremental "precautionary principles" under the radar of most citizens' realization and comprehension. The Socialist agenda is working hard to achieve domination she claims by: 1. limiting natural resources, 2. limiting individual rights to privacy, 3. implementing national health-care, and 4. limiting private property rights.

Are there recent government programs in place now to achieve these goals? According to Baer, "YES!" Look to seemingly benign entities like the EPA, Sierra Club, Homeland Security, USDA and countless others. She reminds us to watch President Obama in June during the 2012 Rio Earth Summit when he hammers the final nail in the environmental/natural resource control coffin by signing "Smart Growth," new legislation which will introduce 52 new agencies to control us even more, including our agriculture!
