Today's Program: July 19, 2011 Timothy A. Jamieson, M.D., Ph.D. CyberKnife, A New Horizon for Cancer Treatment

Dr. Timothy A. Jamieson is the Medical Director of the new Cyber-Knife program at the Southeast Georgia Health System, only the second hospital system in the State of Georgia to have the program. CyberKnife provides a painless, non-invasive treatment that targets tumors with pinpoint accuracy and lightening speed. Having previously directed the CyberKnife Center at Virginia Hospital Center in Arlington, Dr. Jamieson is a board-certified radiation oncologist and trained as a CyberKnife specialist.

Formerly from Atlanta and a graduate of the University of Alabama, Julie Hunter Martin is an enthusiastic community advocate who seized the reins of beautifying and restoring the historic district of Brunswick by starting the Signature Squares of Brunswick project in 2004. The Brunswick city layout and park system are a part of the original city plan designed by General James Oglethorpe in 1771. Since their incorporation, Julie and her highly motivated team of sponsors, donors and volunteers have spearheaded the successful restoration of four park squares including Hanover Square where Julie and family reside in a restored 1880 residence that was once the childhood home of Glynn County Commissioner Clyde Taylor. With ten more historic park squares to tackle, Julie Martin and her team of supporters have their work cut out for them well into the next decade. Julie's interesting talk and dynamic PowerPoint presentation conveyed the spirit of the project which is solely supported by private donations and corporate sponsorships.
