## Timothy A. Jamieson, M.D., Ph.D. **Cyberknife Stereotactic Radio Surgery**

Our speaker was Dr. Timothy Jamieson, a Radiological Oncologist and Medical Director of the Cyberknife Department at Southeast Georgia Health System. Dr. Jamieson gave an informative lecture focusing on new advances in radiation therapy now available at the Brunswick facility through Cyberknife technology. Developed at Stanford and approved by the FDA in 2001, only 220 Cyberknife installations currently exist in the world.

Cyberknife offers state-of-the art radiological therapy in the form of 200 tightly tangled radiation beams in doses 100 times more intense than conventional radiation. Used primarily for types of tumors including prostate, lung, brain and subsets of breast cancer, Cyberknife intensifies the dose of radiation using linear acceleration which continuously tracks the tumor for short intense periods of time. In all cases, Cyberknife shortens the radiation therapy period to as few as five days versus conventional radiation which may extend for eight to nine weeks. The intensity of the Cyberknife beam also allows for concentrated organ penetration eliminating possible radiation damage to other organs and tissue. This technology is also being used to successfully remove vertebral spinal lesions and for neurological repair treatments. At an initial cost of 4.1 million dollars per installation, Cyberknife is capable of treating up to 700 patients a year at the Brunswick facility.
