Her latest is Splendid Isolation, an accurately portrayed historical novel set during the 'Gilded Age' on Jekyll Island. The story chronicles the lives of the wealthy Power Titans who made up the membership of the Jekyll Island Club from 1888 until its demise in 1942. The story is told from the perspectives of four employees who were "in service" to the likes of J.P. Morgan, Andrew Carnegie, Joseph Pulitzer, William Rockefeller, Cornelius Vanderbilt, Cyrus McCormick Jr. and others who made up the elite brotherhood of just 50 Jekyll Island Club members. The book describes the extraordinary lifestyle of the rich and famous during the Club's sixty-year history on Jekyll Island while describing a series of historical 'firsts' which also occurred there, including the first transcontinental phone call and the formation of the powerful Federal Reserve Bank. The glory days all came to an end during World War II when the last Club Member left the island. "Mueller blends fact, fiction and brings history to life detailing how Jekyll Island became an important player in world events...." reported the Georgia Coastal Illustrated.
