Admission to the concert will be \$35. This year, *Military Day* is Thursday, October 13, when men and woman in uniform and retired veterans will receive free admission to The McGladrey. The social hub of the tournament will once again be *The Marketplace* where added activities, entertainment and enhanced food venues will be enjoyed by attendees. Scott reminded the audience of the great economic impact that The McGladrey brings to St. Simons and Glynn County. It is estimated that the tournament generated \$15 million in revenues for businesses in Glynn County in 2010. Organizers estimate that this number will grow this year due to an expected increase in attendance and the addition of more tournament events. The McGladrey is organized and sanctioned by the Davis Love Foundation. All proceeds of The McGladrey benefit children's programs in Glynn County. The Davis Love Foundation estimates that the tournament will raise over \$300,000 for charities this year, up from \$150,000 in 2010. The official sponsor of the tournament is McGladrey – Assurance, Tax and Consulting, the fifth largest accounting firm in the U.S. McGladrey Financial has committed to sponsorship of the tournament through 2012.
