Program: August 23, 2011 **Guney Gul** International Broadcast Journalist

Since our scheduled speaker Steve Landis could not be present due to a death in his family, our guest speaker on August 23 was Guney Gul. Mr. Gul is an international broadcast journalist who boasts a radio audience of over 20 million listeners, transmitting Christian messages into Islamic countries throughout the world and particularly into the Middle East. Originally from Istanbul, Turkey and a follower of the Islamic faith, Guney converted to Christianity a number of years ago. His talk described the Islamic religion as a complex culture of countries scattered around the globe. He cited the many differences of the Muslim people, comparing for example, the strict fundamentalist beliefs and customs of the Saudi people contrasted with the progressive secular position of the Turkish people. He spoke of the many nuances of the religion and its complex tribal evolution which began in the early 7th century as a monotheistic faith that follows Allah.

He talked about the Sunnites, the Shiites and the Kurds, among ther tribal groups. He described it as a religion growing faster than ny other religion in the world. Today Islam is one of the world's ominant religions, and claims one-fifth of the world's population. ne of the reasons for its rapid growth is that most practicing Musns are compelled by their faith to have at least three children, and some Middle Eastern nations can have as many as four wives nd many more concubines. Wanting to avoid any political posturing, Guney's speech spoke in generalities about Islam and its diverse theology. An active question and answer period followed Mr. Gul's prepared presentation.
