## Program: November 1, 2011 **Garrett Silliman** Recreating History Through Archaeology

Garrett Silliman loves history! Particularly Civil War history. That was really evident during his informative talk on the subject at our November 2nd meeting. Introduced by fellow Rotarian, Paul Pieschel. Garrett is Paul's son-in-law.

A graduate in Archaeology from The College of Wooster in Ohio with a M.S. in Historical Preservation from Georgia State, Garrett has worked on archaeological research projects throughout the U.S. He is an expert in Civil War history with an emphasis on the Federal army's activity from Atlanta to Savannah – Sherman's infamous siege of Atlanta and the devastating "march to the sea." The science of defining what actually happened during those bleak days in the summer of 1864 are redefined by minute research uncovering the remnants from the army that "took the South by storm."

He talked about findings at Kennesaw Mountain – debris found in ancient battle bunkers occupied nearly a century-and-a-half ago by Union soldiers. He remarked how different the land must have looked at that time - often barren of trees and vegetation as the battle siege wore on. It was a compelling story and an interesting reminder to all of us who now live and love the South.
