This week's program had three speakers. The first was Mike Hendley, a former member of the SSI Rotary and currently Past President of the Brunswick Club. Mike opened the program with a few words about exciting new initiatives at the Elizabeth F. Correll Teen Center in Brunswick, Sanctioned under Boys & Girls Clubs, the center which opened three years ago is focused on helping inner-city teens stay in school ultimately leading to successful enrollment in college, or as productive members of the work force after high school. A recent Federal grant has supplied the necessary funds to initiate the 'Real Life Program' which will help 150 local high school students learn key initiatives in personal growth with emphasis on academic achievement and career exploration in the five unique career strands: Media, Health & Fitness, Business Management, Vocational, and Hospitality.

Local Boys & Girls Clubs Director Brian Dolan also spoke about the program and described the Teen Center as "a safe place for high school kids after school." He then introduced Dr. Joan Boorman who is responsible for writing the Federal grant and curriculum for the 'Real Life Program' which will be funded from a \$276,000 Federal grant contribution. Dr. Boorman emphasized the importance of community involvement in achieving goals including encouraging local businesses to offer internships and summer job placements to students enrolled in the program. "This program is a partnership," she stated..."A partnership between Boys & Girls Clubs, Glynn County Schools, high school counselors, and the local business community. With everyone's coordinated participation, we will succeed in making a difference for youth in our community, and thereby improve the quality of life in our community at large."
