# **Program for December 6, 2011** Did I really Want to start a Distillery? Presented by Gilbert S. Klemann, MD

Gilbert Klemann made an interesting retirement switch from medical doctor specializing in Obstetrics & Gynecology, to partnering and ownership in a liquor distillery business. His distillery, 13 Colony Distilleries, LLC located in Americus Georgia was founded in 2008. Since then, Gil and partners have learned a lot about the liguor business and how heavily it is regulated by local, state and federal authorities. With a witty, often humorous delivery style, Gil spoke of how his distillery was originally named Rat's Nest Distillery. They changed the name for obvious reasons and proceeded to learn the distillery business from the ground up, ultimately learning to navigate the regulatory hoops governing liquor production by the TTB, BATF, FDA, OSHA, Dept of Revenue, Dept of Agriculture, Dept of Labor and State Departments too!

As the only 'craft' (small 'Mom & Pop') distillery in Georgia, 13 Colony Distillery currently produces vodka, gin, and whiskey products and will introduce their first bottles of bourbon for sale in 2012. He talked about how heavily liquor products are taxed in Georgia, adding \$17.50 of tax to every gallon of liquor produced. He spoke of the high water quality in the state of Georgia and how it adds to the quality of the liquor they create. He offered insight into how liquor is distilled and the unique chemistry that goes into it. He talked about bottling and labeling the product and joked that his "labeling machine actually puts the labels on straight about 25% of the time." It was an interesting and entertaining talk.
