Andrew Dickson **Hunt**, 89, died Thursday, June 16, at Magnolia Manor on St. Simons Island. He was born October 1, 1915, in Staten Island, N.Y. Dr. **Hunt** graduated from Haverford College in Haverford, Pa., and the Cornell Medical School in New York. Upon completion of his internship, he entered the United States Army Medical Corps where he served in the European Theater.

Following his army tour of duty, he went to Children's Hospital in Philadelphia where he served as Chief Resident. His next move took him to **Hunt**erdon Medical Center in Flemington, N.J., as Chairman of Pediatrics. In 1959, he moved to Stanford University in Palo Alto, Calif., as the Director of Ambulatory Services and Associate Professor of Pediatrics. Dr. **Hunt**'s final career move took him to East Lansing, Mich., as the founding Dean of the Medical School at Michigan State University.

Retiring from Michigan State University in 1984, he relocated to St. Simons Island and continued to work in several capacities, including service with the Medical School of Mercer University in Macon, Ga., the Glynn County Health Department and the Hospice of the Golden Isles. Among the many awards garnered during his long medical career, Dr. **Hunt** received the Haverford Award, the college's highest award.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years, Lotta Mayberry **Hunt**; son, George Mayberry **Hunt** of Novato, Calif.; daughters, Elisabeth Hollister **Hunt** of Maynard, Mass., Judith Pinney **Hunt** of South Hampton, N.H., and Lotta **Hunt** Rosen of Richmond, Vt.; five grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

Dr. **Hunt** was a member of Christ Church, Frederica, St. Simons Rotary Club, Ivy League Club and the Golden Isles Council of the Navy League.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, June 20, at Christ Church, Frederica.
