

# Pat Storino

Pat Storino, 83, of St. Simons Island, passed away Thursday, Oct. 2, 2014, with his family by his side.

A celebration of Pat's life will take place Saturday, Oct. 4 at 1 p.m. at Christ Church Frederica, with the Rev. Thomas Purdy residing.

A native of Greenwich, Conn., and raised in Port Chester, N.Y., Pat had been a resident of Glynn County since 1996. Mr. Storino was born July 31, 1931, to the late Joseph and Jean Ferraro Storino.

He was a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania where he received his bachelor's degree, and he was a graduate of Rutgers University where he received his masters degree. Mr. Storino also attended Fairleigh-Dickinson University as well as Seton Hall.

He was employed in the pharmaceutical industry performing, research and development as well as being a quality control engineer with Pfizer, formerly Warner – Lambert, retiring after 44 years of service.

He was a member of the Rotary Club where he was past president and assistant district governor. He was chairman of the flag committee for several years, and was awarded the title chairman emeritus of Taps at Twilight on Memorial Day 2014 for his devotion to the rotary flag committee and the Taps program. He was a member of the Ivy League Club of St. Simons Island where he also held the position as president.

Mr. Storino was a member and treasurer of the Friends of the Library, and the Belle-Italia Club. He was also a member and president of the Shore Birds Social Club, and a member of the Coastal Gun Club. Mr. Storino had been a member of Christ Church, Frederica since 1996 where he held a ministry as an usher and teller.

Mr. Storino was also an avid golfer, loved target shooting, and was known as “#1 Grampy” to his grandchildren. He loved music, participating in a special band with colleagues playing the clarinet and the saxophone.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Storino was preceded in death by his stepmother, Jenette Storino.
